Semester Report Cards

Our semester report cards will be issued on Fri., Jan. 25th. We will be using a 1- 4 rubric scoring each academic strand in 1st - 7th grades. The rubric and associated meaning is outlined below.

4 = Exceeds grade level expectations Student performance demonstrates a thorough understanding of the knowledge and skills expected at this grade level. Student demonstrates a deeper understanding of grade level standards by applying and utilizing concepts and skills.

3 = Meets grade level expectations - Student performance demonstrates a solid understanding of the knowledge and skills expected at this grade level. Student demonstrates consistent use of skills.

2 = Progressing towards understanding grade level skills and concepts - Student performance demonstrates partial progress of the knowledge and skills expected at this grade level. Student is progressing in understanding, however, the skills are not yet mastered.

1 = Limited understanding of grade level skills and concepts - Student performance demonstrates a limited understanding of the knowledge and skills expected at this grade level. Student is working below grade level expectations. Student needs continued support.
