CORONAVIRUS INFORMATION UPDATE

Bear River Health Department (BRHD) has asked that we help reinforce several preventative hygiene practices for children and adults at school and home.

- 1) Wash your hands with soap for 20 seconds or more thoroughly and frequently
- 2) Cover your nose when sneezing and mouth when coughing
- 3) Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth
- 4) Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces and objects
- 5) Avoid contact with people who are sick
- 6) Stay home if you are sick

Additionally, a reminder if you develop a cough, fever, or difficulty breathing:

Call ahead to tell your healthcare provider about your symptoms

DO NOT GO DIRECTLY TO MEDICAL FACILITY WITHOUT CALLING IN FIRST.
